

Adding the Design Tools Toolbox

We have put together a toolbox for ArcView 9 called **Design Tools**.


The **Design Toolbox** has all the geoprocessing tools, buffer tools, and other commonly used tools that have been scattered in various toolbox groups in v9.

Using this toolbox should save you from having to search through the dozens of ESRI ArcView toolboxes included with the standard install.

You will need to add the toolbox to your toolbox menu.


STEP 1

Open ArcMap.




STEP 2

Click on the **ArcToolbox** icon to open the ArcToolbox window.



STEP 3


Right click on ArcToolbox in the Toolbox window, select **Add Toolbox**.






STEP 4

Navigate to **Y:\TMS\ArcView\Modot**, select **Design Tools.tbx**, click on Open.




STEP 5

You will have to repeat the same process to add the toolbox in ArcCatalog.
The toolbox will now be available each time you open either ArcMap or ArcCatalog.

The Design tools are grouped in 3 functional categories; **Geometry, Image, and Table.**



As shown below, each of the main tool group categories contains a collection of tools related to that category.
